Elvira's Healthy Start family support worker helped both her and her child a great deal. The family support worker showed her how to take care of her baby, and even just basic things became important knowledge which she has been able to use with her later children. Elvira's support worker also showed her baby, Jordy, how to do certain things, of which Elvira said "everything that she told and showed my son he did...she helped him to grow better."
