## **Biographical Note**

Patricia (Pat) Dudley is the current President and Marketing Director at Bethel Heights Vineyard located in Salem, Oregon. She is also one of the founders of the Oregon Pinot Camp and former Executive Director of the International Pinot Noir Celebration. She continues to contribute to the Oregon wine industry by participating in everything from sustainable wine certification practices to immigration and land-use laws. Pat and her husband, Ted Casteel, along with his brother Terry and his wife, Marilyn Webb worked collaboratively to establish Bethel Heights Vineyards in 1977. Pat and Marilyn worked

on the business aspect of the winery while Ted managed the vineyard and Terry made the wine. Over the past forty years, the family business has expanded to include members of the second generation and currently produce 13,000 cases a year, most of which is estate grown.

### **Content Description**

This collection contains event programs/wine notes from the *Salud! Oregon Pinot Noir Auction* (1997-2009) in addition to Oregon Wine Association (OWA) Membership Letters and Oregon Grapevine Newsletters. Miscellaneous items include an angry letter from Mr. Charles Coury (an early pioneer of the Oregon wine industry) to William Blosser regarding Coury bringing uncertified material from Draper Valley Vineyards in California, a 1991 order form for the Oregon Winegrape Grower's Guide, a 1992 Edition of the OWA Annual Membership Directory, a 2010 program and wine notes from Bonaventure Senior Living's *Uncorked Auction*, and finally a 1997-1998 Edition of *Burgundy Wine Company Ltd.*
