# Work in the Vineyards

Vineyard work challenges popular assumptions about the nature of agricultural work - managing and nurturing the vineyards requires knowledge and skill. Throughout the year, Latino workers spray and maintain the vines and in the fall harvest the grapes. Like Mario, many play a part in a wide variety of the labor required to make wine, such as bottling, wine storage and preparation for distribution.
