I would be happy to identify the psychodids which you have collected
in Oregon. Send them on when they are ready and I shall identify
them as soon as possible. If the specimens are preserved dry and
unmounted, I would prefer to have them that way. In the event
that they are glued to points please tell me which glue has
been used in order that I may remove some for slide mounts.

I have recently had a similar request from Dr. James, at Pullman,
for identification of psychodids in an ecological study in Washington.
Is your project in any way connected with this?
