The Wildcats took 4th place in the NWC and earned the same ranking in the NAIA District No. 2 meet in Ashland, Oregon

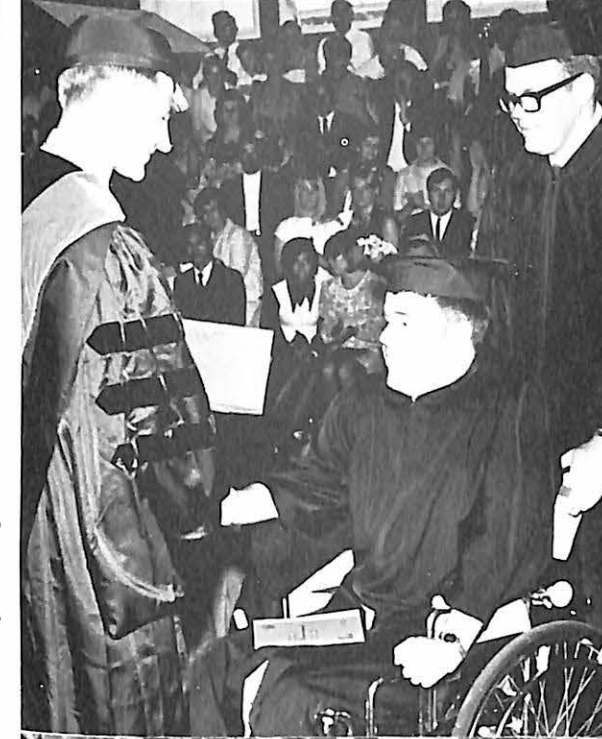
