# 2004 OREGON VINEYARD AND WINERY REPORT

Oregon wine grape production was down 19 percent in 2004 and Oregon wine grape crush was down 15 percent. Decreased wine grape production was attributed to a variety of reasons including poor fruit set for some growers, freezing temperatures, powdery mildew, birds, yellow-jackets and deer. The overall average price per ton for all grape varieties in Oregon increased 10 percent from the previous year. Wine sales were up 7 percent in 2004, with 52 percent of those sales occurring in Oregon. Unfilled wine grape needs reported by wineries were: Cabernet Franc, Dolcetto, Gewurztraminer, Grenache, Marsanne, Marechal Foch, Merlot, Muscat, Petit Verdot, Pinot Gris, Pinot Noir, Riesling, Sauvignon Blanc, Syrah, Tempranillo, Viognier and Zinfandel. Funding for this annual survey is provided by the Oregon Wine Board.
