Mideast: finding signs of hope

A 25-foot, graffiti-scarred concrete wall. Armed guards at crowded checkpoints. Silent, black-clad women standing in the rain. Bereaved families. These are images Jim Ledbetter '51 carried home from Israel and the West Bank.

But he also witnessed both Palestinians and Israelis working for peace in the region.

Ledbetter spent two weeks in November traveling in Israel and the West Bank with a 13-member delegation, Interfaith Peace Builders, organized by the Fellowship of Reconciliation-U.S.A. Ledbetter said he joined the delegation "to meet people in Israel and Palestine, hear their stories and give my support in their struggle."

Ledbetter, a retired executive minister of the American Baptist Church of Oregon, was inspired to get involved after attending the North American Baptist Peace Fellowship conference last summer in McMinnville.

Ledbetter saw Women in Black standing silently in the rain, holding their anti-war signs at Jerusalem's busiest intersection, as one or two members do every Friday in the peace movement that has spread across the globe.

"The most disturbing thing we saw was the wall" being built by Israel inside the West Bank. Soldiers control its gates, where there are bottlenecks and long delays, he added.

In one town, he said, a Lutheran school sits on one side of the wall, and the children who live on the other side cannot attend it.

Still, he also saw signs of harmony and hope. Most of the people he met were peace-loving and committed to working for a just, sustainable peace, Ledbetter said. In one village he saw Islamic and Christian Palestinians living next to Jews, "and they get along great."

Ledbetter said the Mideast trip deeply touched him. "My whole soul has been changed," he said. "It's hard to explain how deeply I feel. I pray for the Palestinian and Israeli people every day."

Adventurer, diplomat: Fischel is a citizen of the world

Joshua Fischel '98 is a citizen of the world, an adventurer, a diplomat and a problem-solver. He is completing a two-year stint as consular officer in the U.S. Embassy in Lusaka, Zambia. This fall, he will move to Algiers to assume a similar role at the

larger American Embassy there.

Although he will miss Lusaka's mild climate and the friendly Zambians, Fischel said, he is looking forward to Algeria, where he can speak French.

"When I was at Linfield, I went to Paris for the fall semester my sophomore year, and that made me choose French as my major," said Fischel, who grew up in Pocatello, Idaho. He later spent a year studying in Avignon, France.

Unsure of his goals upon graduation, Fischel joined the Peace Corps and served from 1998 to 2000 in Jamaica. He then earned a master's degree in international affairs at George Washington University in Washington, D.C., in 2002. That's where he met Mikiko Tsuji, who shares his love of climbing, kayaking, mountain biking and skiing. They married in 2003 in Port-au-Prince, Haiti, where Fischel was temporarily assigned.

As chief of the embassy's consular

section, Fischel provides services and aid to the 2,000 American citizens there, and handles visas for foreign nationals seeking to enter the United States.

In Zambia, he also deals with refugees from Congo, Somalia and other parts of Africa, he said. Fischel also reports on refugee issues in Zambia and helps to administer assistance programs. "I travel to the refugee camps, meet with the people providing aid and make sure they're spending our money wisely," he said.

The Fischels recently bought a home in Driggs, Idaho, where Joshua's parents live. They will spend several weeks there before moving to Algeria in late September.

Fischel said he has been fascinated by Algeria since studying Albert Camus at Linfield and writing his final paper for French on the Algerian-French author.
