# Regal. Resonant. Resplendent.



Those are just three words used to describe the Alice Clement Memorial Organ in Ice Auditorium.

The Casavant organ, a memorial to Clement who served Linfield as the dean of the conservatory from 1922-46, has 2,314 pipes, with 38 stops and 48 ranks. "The organ is composed of three completely independent divisions, each pipe finished to perfection by voicers from the factory right in Melrose Chapel," according to the program from the organ's dedication on Feb. 24, 1969. Since its installation and dedication 45 years ago, the organ has provided memorable concerts to countless audiences.
